Children's Online Privacy Protection Parental Consent Form

In keeping with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (**COPPA**), which requires parental consent for the online collection of personal information from children under 13, please complete this form as verification of consent for your child to utilize various **distance learning programs as part of their education at Christian Life Academy**. Your child may be utilizing various online learning platforms such as Zoom, iXL, Newsela, and others that may contain online assessments, texts, documentation, video content, and more. Their name may be visible on a posted class roster along with all the other participants in the class and may be viewable by those who have a login to your child's specific class (including but not limited to their peers and/or parents.) Depending on the platform, your child may or may not have access to social networking features such as messaging, blogging, contact listings, wikis, forums, email, calendar, and personal profile picture and description. Social networking features vary by platform but some can be viewed by anyone with access as long as your child has an active account. The ability to turn off certain social networking features varies by learning platform and is the student/parent's responsibility to monitor. We request your consent to collect the information of the types described above, without which we will be unable to allow the use of this very worthwhile educational tool by your child.

Regarding virtual or remote learning sessions conducted by teachers over video conferencing platforms such as Zoom or Google Meet:

- Teachers **may** record group lessons online and share with the entire class by observing the following
 - The video is only shared within District-approved platforms such as SeeSaw, Google, etc
 - The recordings of classes and one-on-one teaching are not posted anywhere publically
 - The recordings will not be maintained (stored) beyond the current grading period
 - The teacher will be the sole possessor of the video
 - No personally identifiable information about students is disclosed in the video

- Teachers **may** record individual lessons online by observing the following
 - The video is only shared with teachers, administrators and approved staff supporting or instructing the student
 - The video is only recorded within District approved platforms such as SeeSaw, Google, etc
 - The recordings of one-on-one teaching are not posted anywhere publically
 - The recordings will not be maintained (stored) beyond the current grading period
 - The teacher must be the sole possessor of the video
 - No personally identifiable information about students is disclosed in the video
